### Notice of Race

**Note:** The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

#### 1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2021-24 ("RRS").
- 1.2. The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3. Appendix S shall apply.
- 1.4. Appendix T shall apply.

#### 2. Advertising

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

#### 3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. The regatta is open to boats of the Sunburst and J 14 classes.
- 3.2. Eligible skippers may enter by completing the relevant entry form online:

by 1900hrs Monday 5<sup>th</sup> April 2021

- 3.3 Late entries. A late entry may be accepted at the Organising Authority's discretion until 0900hrs on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2021.

#### 4. Fees

- 4.1. The entry fee for both classes is \$80.00 per boat.
- 4.2. If the regatta is unable to go ahead due to COVID-19 restrictions, a full refund will be issued to all competitors.

#### 5. Schedule

##### 5.1. Registration

## 5.2. Briefing

The briefing is scheduled for 0915hrs on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> April 2021 upstairs in the TSC. This may change depending on the Covid-19 Alert Level and restrictions/guidelines in place at the time.

## 5.3. Dates of Racing

Saturday 10 <sup>th</sup> April	Race Day 1	1 <sup>st</sup> Warning Signal: 1030	4 Races
Sunday 11 <sup>th</sup> April	Race Day 2	1 <sup>st</sup> Warning Signal: 1000	3 Races

## 5.4. Number of Races

- (a) 7 Races are scheduled for the series.
- (b) Up to 4 races may be sailed per day.
- (c) The target time for each race will be 40 minutes for the leading boat.
- (d) On Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> April, no warning signal will be made after 1530hrs

5.5. **Saturday Evening BBQ** – after racing Saturday. Tickets available at Registration.

## 6. Measurement

### 6.1 Sunburst Class

- 6.1.1 Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate and shall display a current registration sticker on its transom.
- 6.1.2 All sails shall have been previously measured and stamped by a Sunburst Class Measurer.
- 6.1.3 Hulls may be weighed before or during the event.
- 6.1.4 There shall be only one set of sails, spars and foils used by each boat. These shall be declared at Registration. (refer NOR5.1 above).  
Any changes must be requested and approved by the Race Officer in writing.
- 6.1.5 Each boat shall complete a measurement/safety checklist during at Registration.
- 6.1.6 There will be no sail, boat or foil measurement at the event unless previously arranged with a Sunburst Class Measurer.

### 6.2 J 14 Class

- 6.2.1 Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate.
  - 6.2.2 Each boat shall produce a valid J 14 WOF at the time of registration and display a 2020-2021 WOF sticker on its transom.
  - 6.2.3 Measurement and WOF checks may be available during scheduled Registration (refer NOR5.1 above) and must be pre-booked and shall be at the discretion of the Class Measurer
- 6.3 Entrants are encouraged to complete Registration Friday 9<sup>th</sup> April due to the tight time constraints on Race Day 1. (Refer NOR 5.1 above)
- 6.4 All beach trailers/trolleys must have their boat's sail numbers clearly marked on them.
- 6.5 Safety and measurement checks may be made on any boat at any time during the event.

## 7. Sailing Instructions

7.1. Printed Sailing Instructions will not be made available. The Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSI) will be posted on the TSC website by 0900 on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> April 2021 and will also be posted on the Official Notice Board.

## 8. Venue

- 8.1. Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue.
- 8.2. The Racing area is the waters off Waiake Beach, Torbay.

## 9. Courses to be Sailed

9.1. The courses to be sailed will be triangular courses including windward, reaching and leeward marks.

## 10. Penalty System

10.1. Rule 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that the 'Two-Turns' penalty is replaced by the 'One-Turn' Penalty.

## 11. Scoring

11.1. One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.2. When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

11.3. When 6 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 12. Launching

12.1 Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from Waiake Beach.

## 13. Coaching and Support Boats

13.1. Support boats are allowed.

## 14. Radio Communication

14.1. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP].

## 15. Prizes

15.1. Prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

## 16. Insurance

16.1 It is highly recommended that each participating boat shall be insured with valid marine third-party liability insurance to a minimum of \$1,000,000--

## 17. Disclaimer of Liability

17.1 Competitors participate in all races entirely at their own risk. Refer to RRS rule 4. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the race.
