NOTICE OF RACE (NOR)

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply. Refer http://www.yachtingnz.org.nz/racing/safety-regulations
- 1.3 Under RRS 86, Changes to The Racing Rules the following racing rules will be changed as follows:
 - RRS 35, A4 and A5 will be changed to state that boats still racing but failing to finish within 15 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes may be given a finishing position based on the last mark they rounded and/or their position on the course. Their score will be greater than any boat who rounded further marks or who finished,
 - RRS 44.1 will be changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced with the One-Turn penalty for those classes listed in the Supplementary Sailing Instructions,
 - RRS 60.1(a) will be changed to state that a competitor cannot protest another boat or competitor for breaches of some specific parts of the Sailing Instructions or Supplementary Sailing Instructions,
 - RRS A4 and A5 will be changed to state that a boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start.
 The changes will appear in full in the Supplementary Sailing Instructions. The Supplementary Sailing Instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 1.4 The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be located on the website.
- 1.5 Appendix T, Arbitration will apply.



1.6 Appendix P — Special Provision for Rule 42 may apply, as amended by the Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Club racing is open to all Junior, Youth and Senior dinghy and wind foiling classes.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing either the electronic Sign On sheet or the paper Sign on sheet at the club.
- 3.4 Changes to boat details must be noted on the Sign On sheet on race day.
- 3.5 Non TSC club-members shall not be eligible for season points. However, points will be backdated two weeks from when they subsequently become a member.
- 3.6 Members who have not paid their membership and/or storage fees within four weeks of becoming a member may be scored DNC for races sailed after that date.

4 CLASSIFICATION

There are no classification requirements in accordance with RRS 79.

5 FEES

Class	Fee
Club members	Free
Non-club members	\$20 per Sunday

6 FLEET RACING

Depending on the number of competitors in each class, some classes may start and race together as one fleet, although each class shall be scored separately.

7 SCHEDULE

7.1 Registration: Each race day from 0900 to 1000 hrs, at the Torbay Sailing Club.

7.2 Briefing:

Each race day, at 1000 hrs, at the Torbay Sailing Club.

7.3 Dates of racing:

Refer to Calendar on the Torbay Sailing Club website - Calendar



- 7.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race each day is 1100 hrs.
- 7.5 Three races are scheduled each race day, however up to four races may be sailed.
- 7.6 Races may be sailed back-to-back.
- 7.7 No warning signal will be made after 1400 hrs.
- 7.7 End of Season social event will be held as soon as possible after completion of racing on Sunday 19th May 2024.

8 MEASUREMENT

- 8.1 A boat shall comply with RRS 78.1
- 8.2 Beach trolleys shall be prominently marked with the boat's sail number.
- 8.3 Spot measurement and safety checks may be conducted at any time throughout the season.

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Appendix S shall apply.

Supplementary Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Torbay Sailing Club Website <u>www.torbaysailing.club</u> no later than 0900 hrs Sunday 10th September 2023.

Paper copies will not be issued to competitors.

10 VENUE

- 10.1 Attachment A shows the location of the Torbay Sailing Club.
- 10.2 Attachment B shows the approximate location of the racing area.

11 THE COURSES

- 11.1 Round-the-buoy course(s) shall use laid marks and be windward/leeward, triangle and/or trapezoid courses, or any other configuration the Race Committee deems fit.
- 11.2 The course to be sailed, and the description of the marks, will be posted on the whiteboard prior to racing and will be explained at the pre-race briefing.



12 SCORING

- 12.1 Appendix A shall apply.
- 12.2 RRS A9 shall apply to the Season Points.
- 12.3 Scoring Abbreviation VOL will be used for sailors on their rostered days to help run racing.

These sailors will be awarded 1 point for races finished that day, up to a maximum of three volunteer days for 18+ year old & two volunteer days for 15-18 year olds. For any subsequent volunteer days average points will be awarded for any races held.

- 12.4 No club points may be awarded for National Championship & Auckland Championship regatta weekends for all classes. Changes can be made prior to regatta date by the fleet captain if supported by the Sailing Committee for individual classes.
- 12.5 7 races are required to constitute a series.

(a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 10 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her X worst scores, where X is the number of races completed, divided by 5, rounded down.

13 SUPPORT BOATS

All support boats must register with the Organising Authority at registration and nominate the boat(s) they support.

14 LAUNCHING AND STORAGE

- 14.1 All competing boats shall be launched and retrieved from Waiake Beach near the Torbay Sailing Club clubhouse, unless instructed otherwise by the Organising Authority.
- 14.2 All beach trolleys must be stacked neatly on the beach on the southern side of the boat ramp.

15 RADIO COMMUNICATION



Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

16 PRIZES

- 16.1 Prizes will be awarded as per the Torbay Sailing Club website Club Racing
- 16.2 Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

- 17.1 Competitors participate in club racing entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the event.
- 17.2 RRS 3 states: 'the responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform, and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury, or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

18 RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the Organising Authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use, and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings, and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.


